

# Wild Water Racing Star Awards

## Registration Process

Award is open to Members and Non-members

Registration is via a WWSLR form that is downloadable from the web.

The Registration Fee is £10.00 for members or £20.00 for non-members

Upon registration the entrant to the 3 Star will have their registration recorded in a similar fashion to the Racing Modules on the database etc.

A WWR 3 Star Log Book will be sent out with Name, Home Nation Number and a unique number of the log book recorded on the front cover. This number will be recorded as having been issued to them.

The Registration Fee will cover the Certification Fee after completion

## Training Process

Training can be carried out by any coach who has the remit to coach in the environment where the training is carried out, equally some of the activities could be trained by a specialist in that field (PE Teacher at school for the fitness etc).

Candidates could go straight to assessed sessions if they are already competent, they would need to show some evidence of knowledge and experience at the right level in the sport. The assessor must be at least a WWR Coach Level 3 (old or new) who has been registered with their Home Nation as an assessor for the WWR 3 Star.

## Assessment Process

Assessments do not have to take place during a single session and can be spread out over a period of time. They may have to be conducted on different stretches of water or even different rivers to get the right features for the particular tasks.

Skills etc. will be signed off by an assessor and the assessor will also put their name and Home Nation Number etc on the back of the log book to verify their signature.

Event attendance can be verified by a Race Organiser or the Coach of the candidate, Copies of Race results must accompany the logbook or a ranking reference with a list of races completed.

For full transparency, trainers will not be able to assess paddlers they have been involved with in terms of training for the WWR 3 Star.

## Awarding Process

On completion of all the tasks and assessments, the log book will be returned to the issuing Home Nation Office for checking and certification, there is no extra fee for this as it is already included in the registration fee.

The certificate will be sent from the Home Nation on a Standard Star Test Certificate with Wild Water Racing imposed before the 3 on the certificate. The log book suitably endorsed will also be returned to the candidate with the Certificate

There needs to be appropriate additions to the database created for registering and printing the certificates.
