

## British Canoeing Level 2 Transfer Course Guide Supplement

The British Canoeing Level 2 transfer course provides a fast track option for coaches, who qualified prior to the introduction of British Canoeing UKCC endorsed awards, to achieve the British Canoeing Level 2 Certificate in Coaching Paddlesport. The transfer course is open to coaches with British Canoeing Level 2 or above. Successful completion of the Level 2 transfer course gives the candidate an equivalent position in their progress towards the qualification as a candidate who has completed the full Level 2 training course.

The British Canoeing Level 2 Course Guide provides an overview of the qualification for candidates following the full Level 2 training course. Differences for transfer candidates are detailed below:

### **Registration and Prerequisites** (see Course Guide page 8)

Candidates need to register before attending a Level 2 transfer course. Details are available from the Home Nation Associations. Candidates registering for Level 2 transfer need these prerequisites:

- Updated British Canoeing Level 2 Coach or above (achieved before 2008)
- Registration Fee £39 for full Home Nation Association Members

All other information detailed on page 8 of the course guide is applicable.

### **The Level 2 Training Course** (see Course Guide page 9)

A coach who wishes to follow the Level 2 transfer route will complete a 7 to 14 hour transfer course. This aims to fast track through the full Level 2 training course content taking into account assumed prior knowledge based on existing qualifications held. Content will also be tailored to canoe and/or kayak depending on the choice of assessment route.

By the end of the transfer course coaches should:

- understand the role and remit of a Level 2 Coach
- understand the Level 2 coaching behaviours
- understand the Level 2 Candidate Portfolio requirements
- be able to identify gaps in current ability in order to prepare for the Final Assessment Tasks

The Level 2 transfer course remains valid for 12-months. Candidates should complete all elements required for certification within 12-months of the transfer course. Extensions are offered on the same basis as Level 2 training, see Course Guide page 12.

### **Assessment:**

There are no differences for transfer candidates in the Candidate Portfolio or Final Assessment Tasks. The Level 2 transfer course is used as evidence of Level 2 Coach Training within the Assessment Prerequisites. The standard Level 2 Assessment Paperwork is used; no other adjustments are required.
