A British Canoeing Coach refers to either current or 'old' scheme awards, unless specifically noted.

Note 1: For courses of 4 or less, two different assessors must assess the candidate. While a different assessor would assess the candidate on each day, both assessors must be present together at the candidates debrief.

Note 2: Additional requirements are detailed in the Level 2 Tutor and Assessor Notes applicable to courses running 1:4, 2:7 or 2:8.

Providers must seek permission from their Home Nation Association if they wish to run courses outside these ratios.
