**Directions:** Registration - in the Community Centre car park, Bridge Street Bonnybridge FK4 1AA

The start & finish area for all courses is the canal bridge at Bonnybridge

**Safety:** All competitors ranked in divisions 7, 8 & 9 and all Lightning paddlers must wear buoyancy aids. They are discretionary for all other paddlers although all paddlers are advised to wear them and dependant on water and weather conditions the organiser may insist on all paddlers wearing approved buoyancy aids. All boats used in marathon racing **must be fitted** with sufficient buoyancy to support the boat and crew in the event of a capsise. Inherent buoyancy in composite boats is not sufficient to meet this requirement. Additional foam buoyancy or air bags must be fitted. Boats may be inspected before the start.
