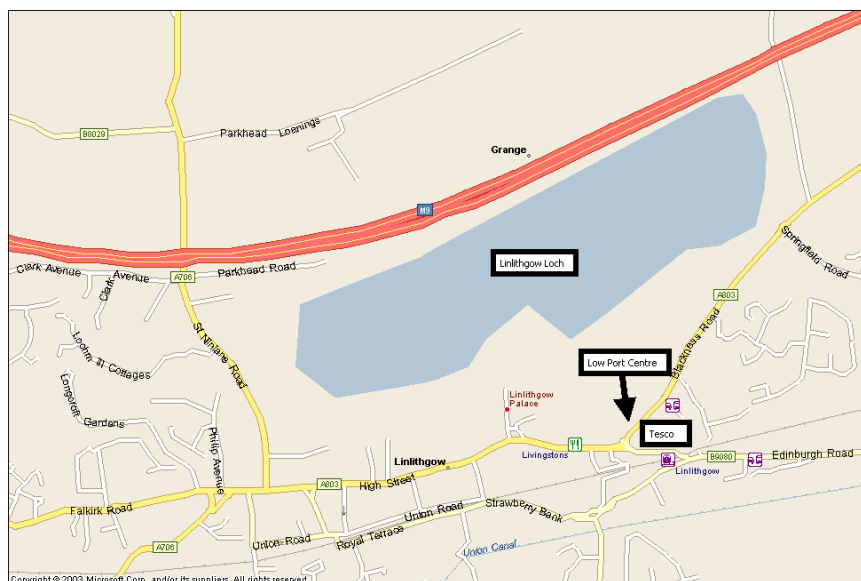

Directions : From the East – Leave the M9 @ junction 3, turn Left for Linlithgow, carry on along the A803 into the town, just before the mini roundabout turn right into the Low Port Centre (opposite Tesco).

From the West – Leave the M9 @ junction 4, take the A803 off the roundabout for Linlithgow, carry on towards the town, straight on at the traffic lights (Mill Rd), straight on at the traffic lights (Sainsburys), straight on at the mini roundabout, through the town to the next mini roundabout (Tesco), take the first junction to the left, then immediately turn left again into the Low Port Centre.

From the South – Leave the M8 @ junction 4 – take the A801/A706 for Linlithgow – follow the signs for approx 8 miles – once you reach the town, straight on at the roundabout (Kettilstoun), traffic lights under the railway, at the next roundabout turn right towards the town centre, through the town to the next mini roundabout (Tesco), take the first junction to the left, then immediately turn left again into the Low Port Centre.

Parking: - There will be a shortage of parking space at Low Port & we are asking when boats are dropped off at Low Port that cars are moved to one of the long term car parks at the East end of the town (NOT Tesco's – they have a 2 hr limit).

Buoyancy aids are compulsory for all lightning paddlers, all U14's and paddlers in Divisions 7, 8 & 9 or D. They are discretionary for all other paddlers, although all paddlers are advised to wear them. In adverse weather conditions the race organiser may require all paddlers to wear buoyancy aids. A rescue boat will be in operation during the event.

Non-native species

Please ensure that your boat & equipment is either dry or has been thoroughly flushed out away from the Loch catchment area to avoid the possible transfer of non-native species.
