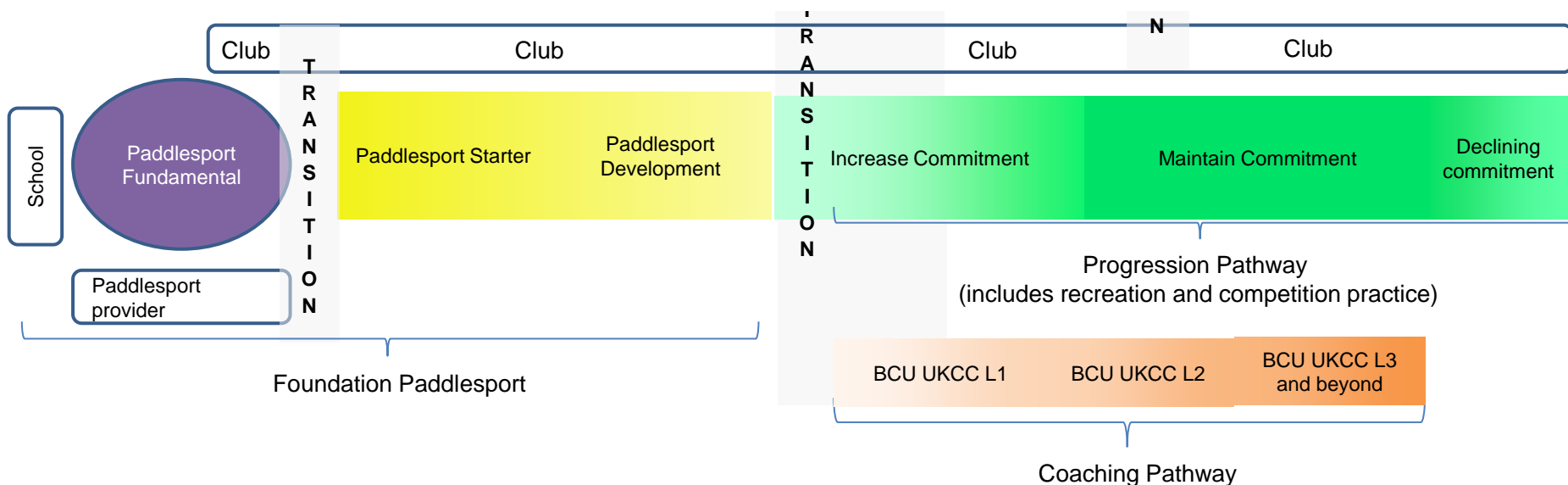

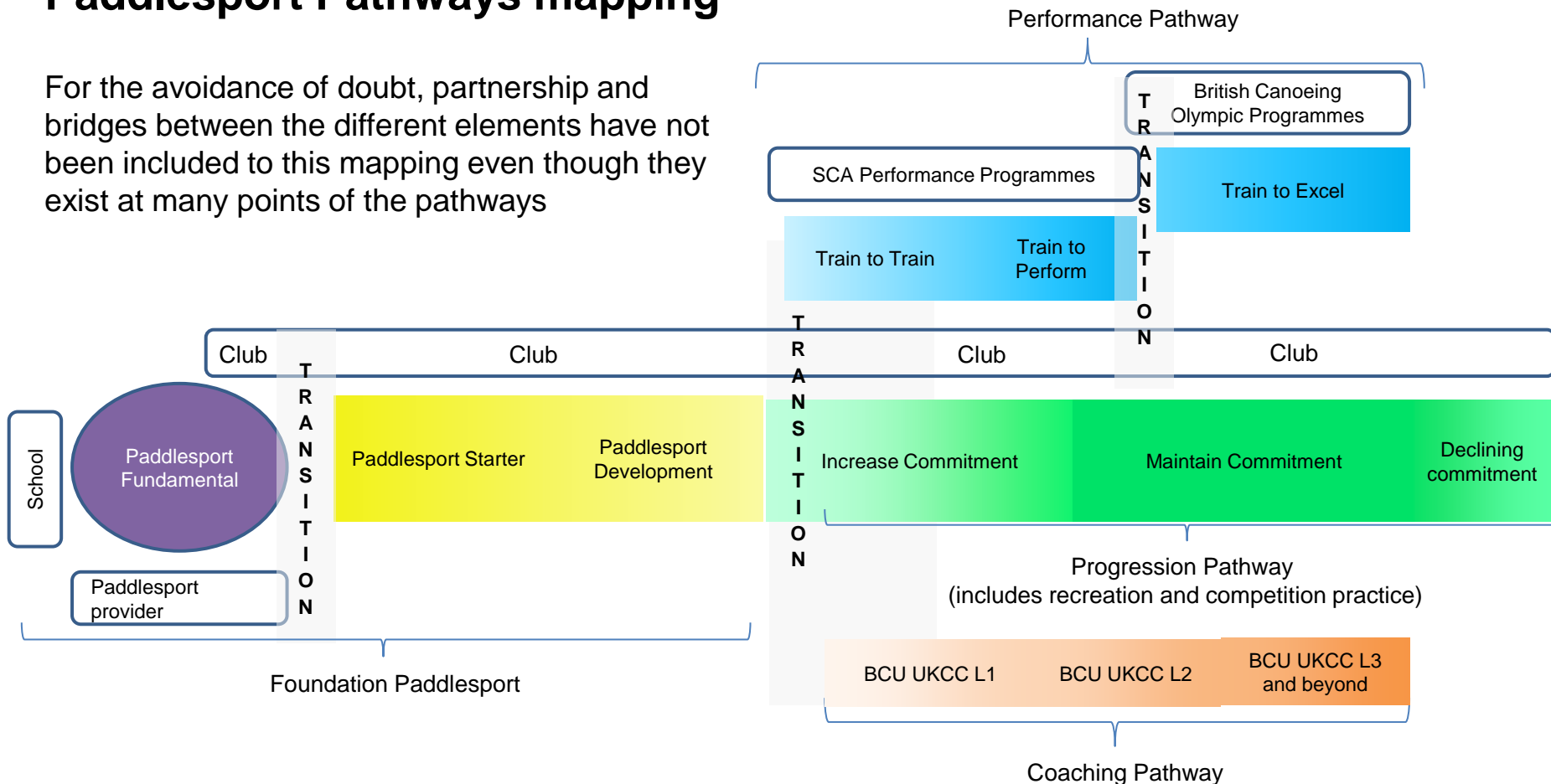
Paddlesport Pathways mapping



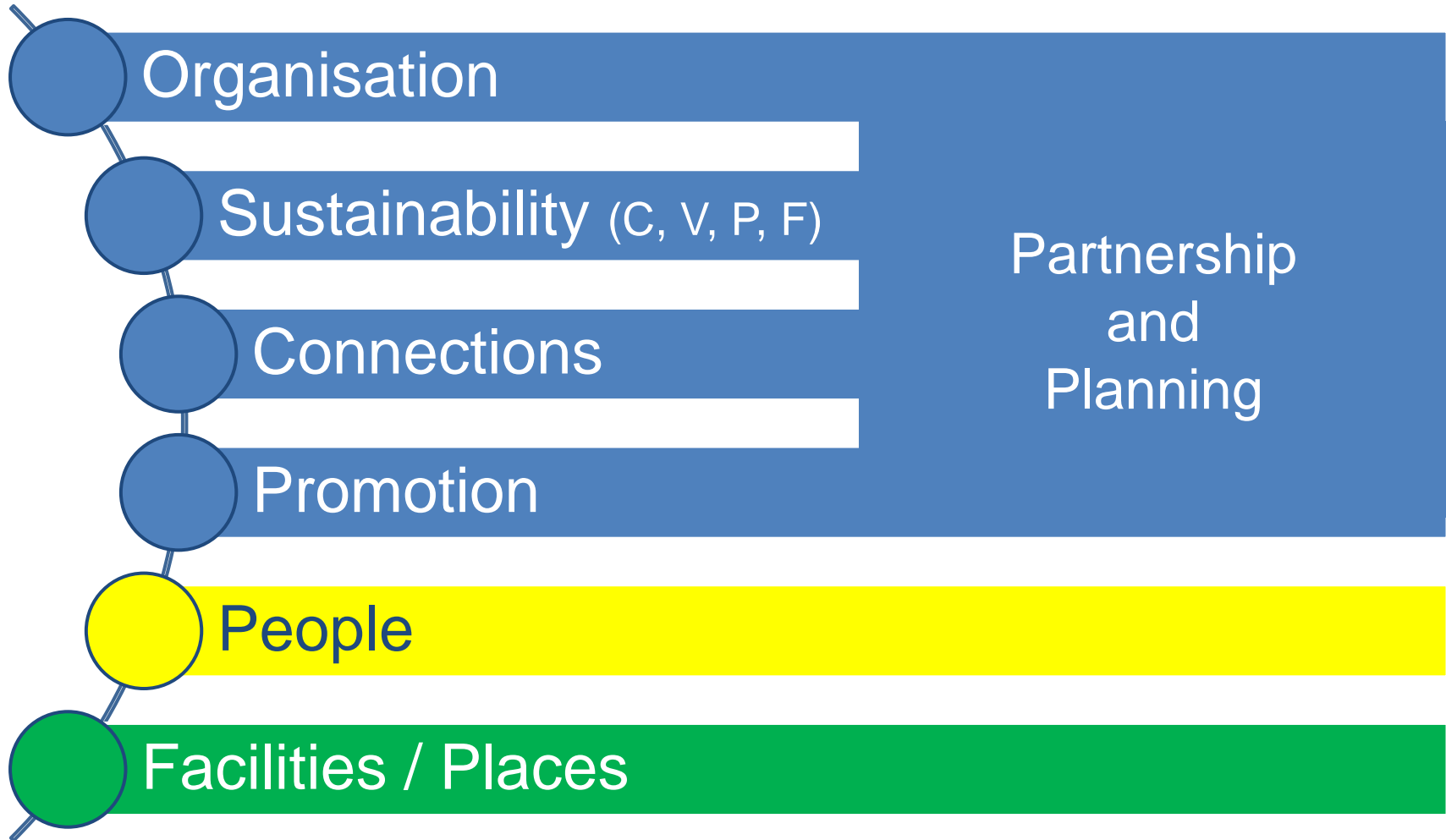

For the avoidance of doubt, partnership and bridges between the different elements have not been included to this mapping even though they exist at many points of the pathways

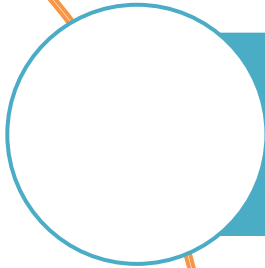


Club Sport development Framework

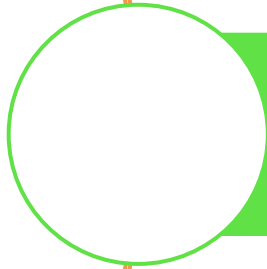

Where do we want to be?

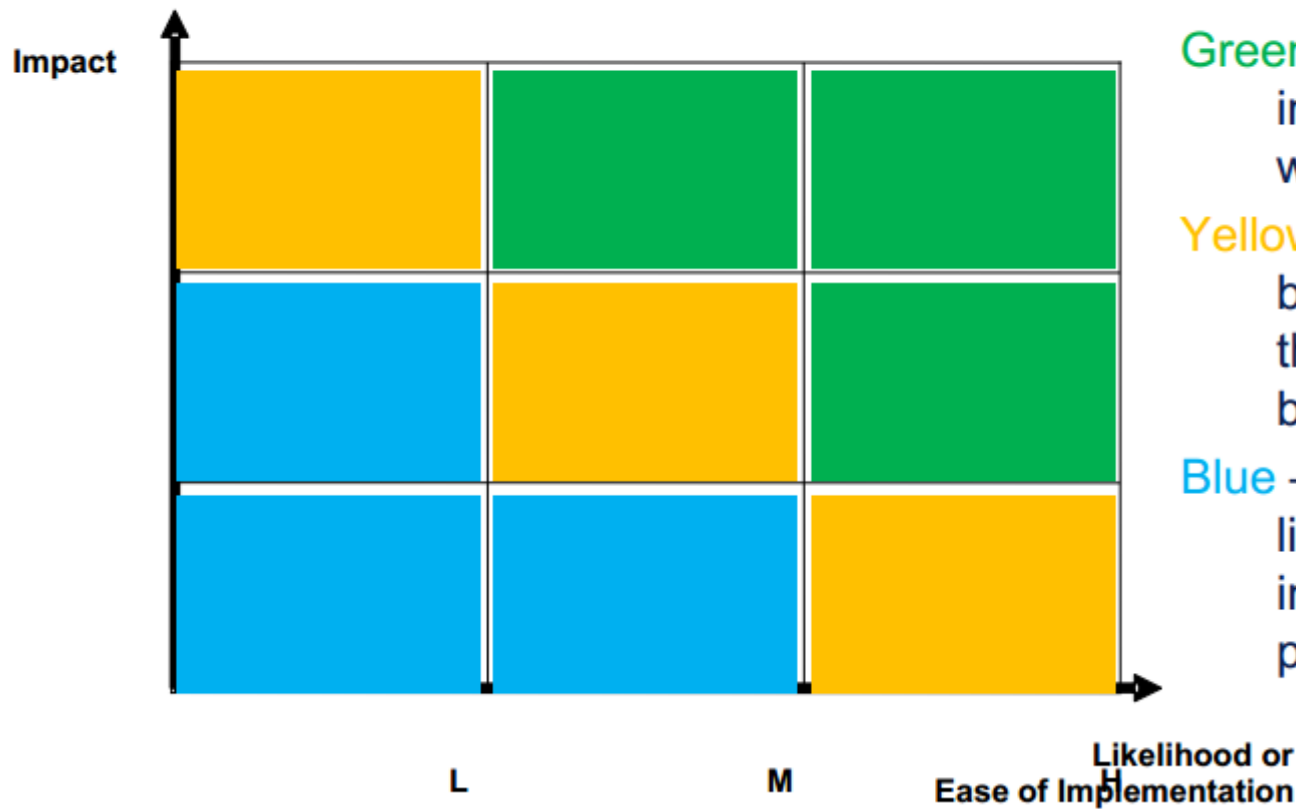


How are we going to get there?

Green – Probably high impact and easy to do or will very likely get done

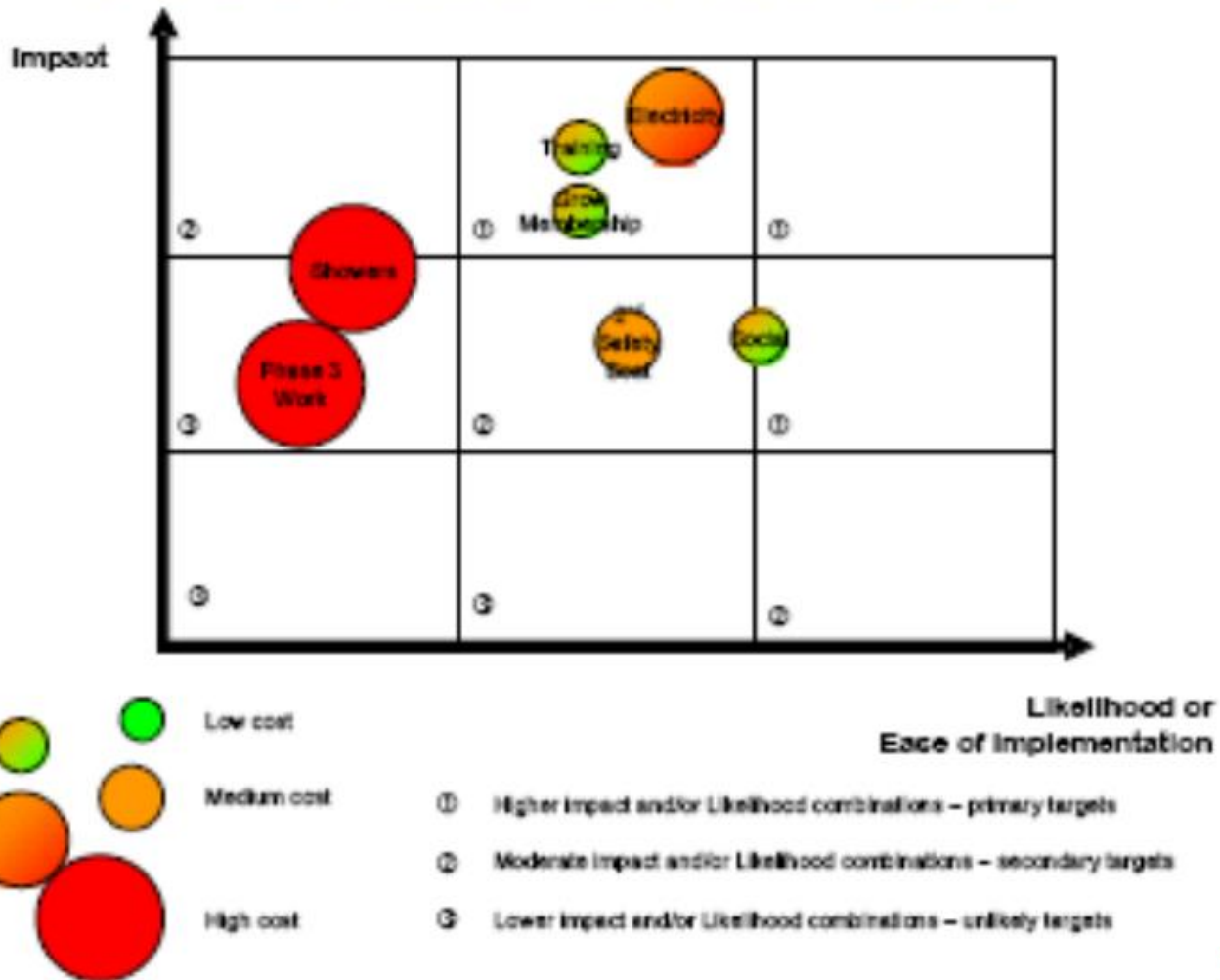
Yellow – Secondary priority but if we can do this there would be some benefit to us

Blue – Low impact and low likelihood of implementation. Low priority.

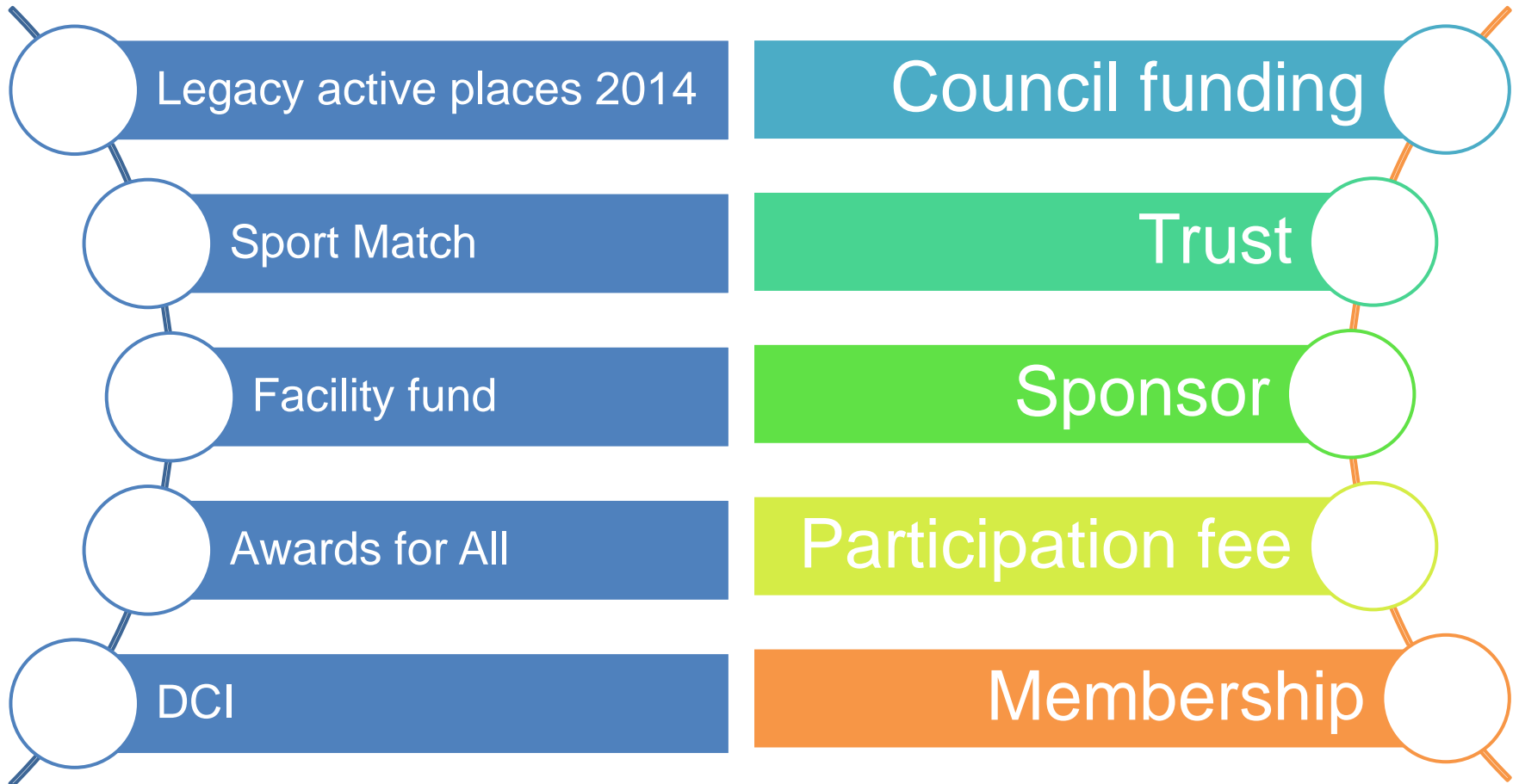

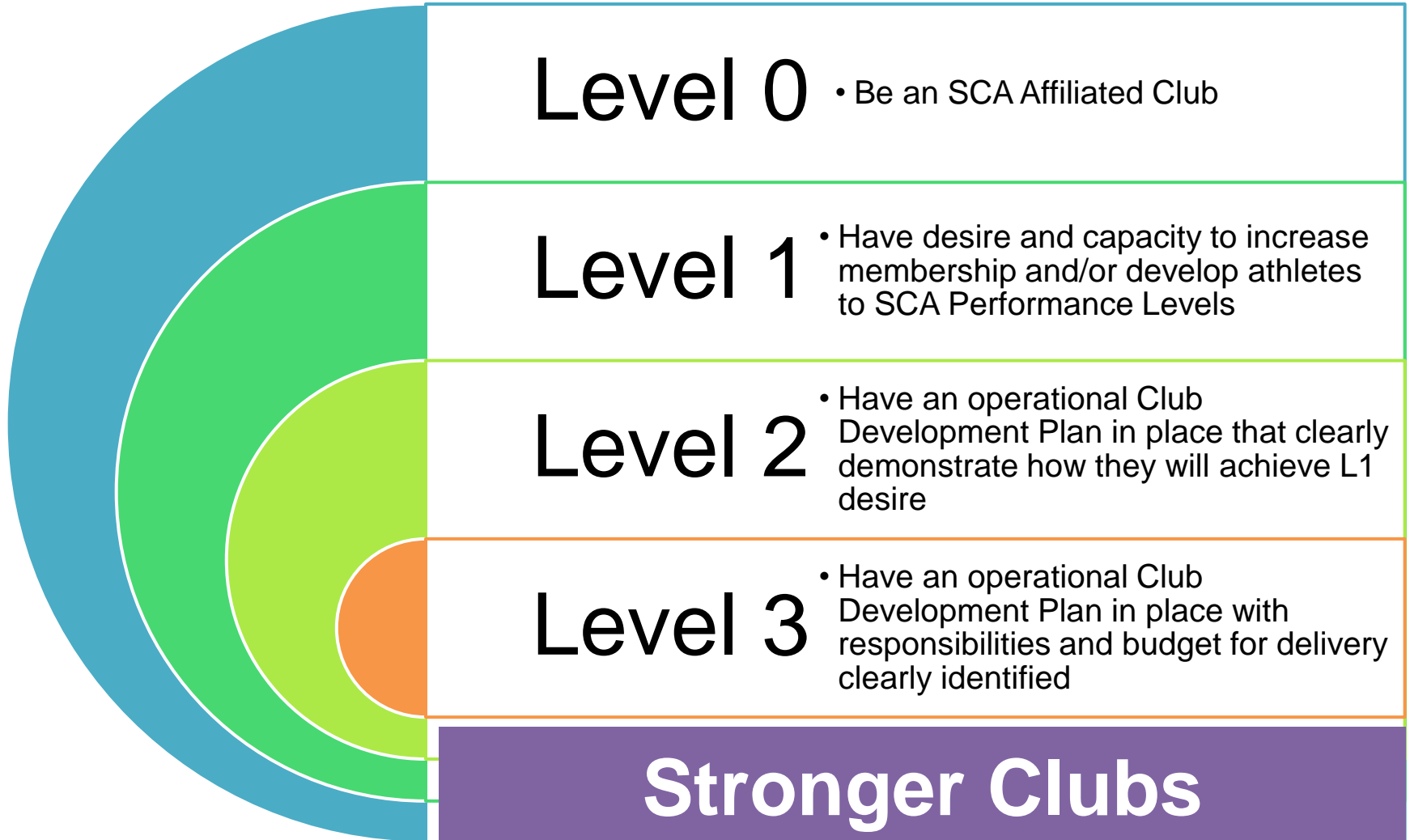
